Reading Train Care Depot Implementation Works, Reading, Berkshire

Commissioning authority | Network Rail Principal designer | Jacobs Engineering Principal contractor | VolkerFitzpatrick This breakthrough project was part of Network Rail's £850M Reading Station Area Redevelopment Programme (RSAR). The objective was the relocation First Great Western's existing diesel maintenance unit (DMU) depot to make way for the new eastern chord and Reading Viaduct.

This new train care depot, delivered by VolkerFitzpatrick, provides stabling, servicing and maintenance facilities for 100 DMUs complete with future capacity for 47 new HLOS electric trains, Crossrail and IEP trains. This is the first completely new facility of its kind to be built in the Great Western railway since 1910.

Team performance was consistently high, reflected by excellent monthly PRISM scores (Network Rail's performance measurement tool). It was the first to achieve 100% score and is ranked in Network Rail's national top 10. Delivering safely was paramount – the team was commended by Network Rail for its health and safety excellence and was presented with:

- 56 STARs monthly award, 1 per worksite
- Prestigious regional Platinum Badger Award – winner twice in succession
- Considerate Constructor
  Performance Beyond Compliance
  certificate.
