Caunton supplied structural steelwork for the Ellis Guilford School in Basford, Nottingham. The project comprised of a total investment of over £12 million.

The client for this project was Nottingham's Local Education Partnership (LEP), which was a public, private partnership between the council and 'Inspiredspaces'. 'Inspiredspaces' was a company set up by Carillion and its joint venture partners to deliver educational transformation through the governments Building Schools for the Future programme. This was the twelfth school that the LEP rebuilt and remodelled in Nottingham, with Caunton supplying and erecting steelwork for five of these. For this project, Caunton supplied 215 tonnes of steelwork, plus metal decking and precast concrete stairs, directly to Carillion.

Caunton were delighted to have supplied steelwork for such schools which benefited the younger generation and the region overall.
