On a design and build contract, Caunton supplied 1,000 tonnes of steelwork to the City of Lincoln's Transport Hub. This £30 million scheme was a significant regeneration project that transformed the city centre of Lincoln. This transformation provided a state of the art bus station, retail space, pedestrian plaza and a 1,000 space multi-storey car park.

The company's Technical Team designed the steelwork frame, alongside fabricating and erecting the steelwork. The frame supported pre-cast concrete slabs, which, in the interest of speed construction, were erected by Caunton alongside the steelwork.

The car park was originally going to be a precast concrete structure, but was instead changed to a steel-framed solution due to steel offered cost and speed of construction benefits.
