The site itself, Gravelly Point, was an exciting logistics manufacturing development, which extended approximately 16 acres, was strategically located close to Junction 6 of the M6 (Spaghetti Junction) on Birmingham's premier Industrial and Distribution Estate, Gravelly Industrial Park. The project is designed to achieve an EPC A rating, has targeted a BREEAM 'Outstanding' and is to be a Net Zero Carbon development. KJ Tait, the professional practice of Building Services Engineers, were the BREEAM Assessors on this project.
