Caunton were pleased to supply the structural steelwork for retail giant Asda, when the company extended the size of their store in Llandudno by over 50%. After the extension it was one of the largest Asda stores in North Wales.

The Asda project itself was managed by major contractor RG Group on a design and build contract. This was unusual for Asda, but it did as a result encourage the introduction of several innovation associated with design and build. For example, Caunton designed and erected the 445 tonnes, 72 metre wide propped mansard frames in only seven weeks and in a specific sequence, which enabled the main contractor to start with other trades as early as possible. This was to achieve a very tight programme.

The consulting engineer for the overall project was GD Partnership and the architect was Mason Richards Partnership.
