Caunton supplied the steelwork for a Tesco Extra store in Chesterfield. The 9.5 acre site brought by Tesco was part of a 22 acre site originally purchased by developer Wilson Bowden and was the former Dema Glass factory. Dema were once one of the largest manufacturers of domestic glassware in Britain. When the overall development was complete it was planned to house the new football stadium for the local league team Chesterfield FC.

The store itself was designed on stilts to first floor level, with a 995 space car park underneath.

The contract for Caunton comprised of 1,825 tonnes of steelwork and the site programme was a speedy 10 weeks.
