The Nottingham University Samworth Academy was a steel framed two storey complex into five blocks. These are designated as the Main Teaching Block, Science Block, Lecutre / Drama Block and the Sports Block. The frame was generally a simple 'beam and column' structure with single pitched roofs. Design of the steelwork was by Atkins, with the connections design by Caunton.
