Caunton supplied the steelwork for a new supermarket, which at the time, was one of the largest of its kind in London. Operated by Sainsbury's, this encompassed 12,000m<sup>2</sup> of sales floor area. This phase, of what was entitled the Northumberland Development Project, announced by Tottenham Hotspur's Football Club last year, also included 10,200m<sup>2</sup> of commercial and educational space above the supermarket. The club also announced that it was committed within the Northumberland Project to develop a new £400 million stadium development.

McLaren Construction was appointed as main contractor to build the supermarket and commercial / educational space to the north of the Tottenham Hotspur's new stadium.

Caunton was responsible for the design and construction of the steel frame, which comprised of 2,500 tonnes of structural steelwork.
