Caunton Engineering designed and supplied the structural steelwork for a John Lewis Group store in Basingstoke. The site, Basing View, was a 65-acre business park in the heart of Basingstoke town. The developer of this store is Muse Developments Basingstoke.

Caunton worked for main contractor Bowmer and Kirkland and erected 900 tonnes of steelwork. The multi-million pound development comprised of a 47,500 square foot John Lewis at Home store as well as a 25,500sq.ft Waitrose food store and a customer café.

Caunton have also completed the supply of steelwork for a similar store in Horsham. On this occasion, the developer was Westrock and the main contractor was Simons Construction.
