Caunton have supplied 1,000 tonnes of main and secondary steelwork to main contractor Simons Construction. The multi-million pound scheme included the provision of retail, housing and then relocation of the town's existing Waitrose shop in Piries Place to Albion Way, Horsham.

The store comprised of a Waitrose supermarket and a John Lewis at Home store. The proposal by developer Westrock was to deliver a quality 29,000sq.ft food store and a large, dedicated car park of 330 spaces, which met the needs of Waitrose customers, as well as the town as a whole. The John Lewis store created 125 jobs, whilst Waitrose created 50 jobs. This project was the start of Westrock's £35 million redevelopment of the west end of Horsham.

Caunton supplied the steelwork for the store and the open deck car park, along with metal decking, secondary steelwork and erecting pre cast lift cores.
